**Description:** The community kitchen serves between 200 and 400 hot, nutritious meals daily (six days a week) to hungry men, women and children. Hours are 9am to 11am. No reservations necessary.

**Eligibility:** Men, women and children who are hungry and in need of a hot meal

**Intake Procedure:** Walk-ins accepted Monday through Saturday 9am-11am

**Hours:** Monday-Friday 9am-4pm

**Description:** The food pantry provides family packages of cookable food, hygiene supplies, job listings, telephone usage, recives mail for homeless, bus passes, counseling and referral services; this is traditionally a quarterly program (once every three months). However, elderly and disabled are served on a monthly basis. Must have written referral from a non-profit or faith-based agency.

**Eligibility:** Anyone in need. Assistance is limited to 1x every 3 months or monthly for elderly/disabled. Referral from an agency required.

**Intake Procedure:** Photo ID required for member picking up and Social Security cards for all household members; Call to arrange time for pick up

**Eligibility:** Economically stressed individuals or families who need food, clothes and counseling

**Intake Procedure:** Photo identification required; assessment and evaluation done at initial intake. Must call central office for referral

**Hours:** Monday-Friday 2:00pm-3:30pm (for food distribution); Clients will not be served before 2:00pm

**Description:** WE CARE ( With Energy, Compassion And Responsible Effort) is the community service outreach program of the Soref JCC agency; Serves as a food bank with food distributed to those in need; client must be referred by another agency or program. Can only assist once every 3 months for food assistance.

**Eligibility:** Those in need of food; Must bring photo ID and/or SS card for each family member. Must have a written referral.

**Intake Procedure:** Requires a written referral, photo ID & SS card. Client MUST call Soref directly, between 11am-4pm, to arrange food pick-up
