**Description:** Low-income individuals and families are assisted toward social and economic stability and self-sufficiency through intake, assessment, and referral. Services provided by Family Success Center and Community Action Agency staff include emergency assistance for rent and mortgage, food, transportation, self-sufficiency case management and mental health counseling. Co-located community providers offer job information and placement, child care information, housing assistance, consumer counseling, substance abuse counseling and other services tailored to the area served by the center.

**Eligibility:** Must be low-income individuals or families; eligibility of services vary (call for more information). Legal immigration status

**Intake Procedure:** (Call in advance for info; ID, Birth Cert, Social Security card, income verification, Rent/utility notices and loss of income)

**Description:** They provide emergency rent and mortgage financial assistance. Provides assessments and referrals for short term needs which include provisions of food, clothing and utility assistance (food pantry distribution is available all day Monday through Friday to individuals with proper criteria). Clothing vouchers available to individuals just released from prison who have a photo ID and orange card.

**Eligibility:** Must show need or severe temporary financial hardship.

**Intake Procedure:** Must provide proof of expenses, income, photo ID, prison orange card & termination notice. Walk-ins accepted for food/clothes
