Medical Rehabilitation includes physical, occupational, and speech-language therapies; psychological evaluations, hearing testing and hearing aids; early intervention services.

Eligibility: Must be under 21 and in need of described services

Fees:: Insurance, Medicaid, Medicaid HMO, Self-pay/full, Sliding scale; \$60 for 1/2 hr per session Hearing aids \$800-\$2500.

Intake: Must provide insurance, medical card and proof of income if applying for financial aid (sliding scale)
